

**NOTICE TO HOLDERS
OF
NEXTERA ENERGY PARTNERS, LP
0% CONVERTIBLE SENIOR NOTES DUE 2025
(CUSIP 65341B AD8)**

This notice is for informational purposes only. No action is required of the holders of the Notes as a result of this notice or the events described herein.

Reference is made to that certain Indenture dated as of December 3, 2020 (the “**Indenture**”) between NextEra Energy Partners, LP (the “**Company**”), NextEra Energy Operating Partners, LP (the “**Guarantor**”) and The Bank of New York Mellon, as trustee (the “**Trustee**”) for the Company’s 0% Convertible Senior Notes due 2025 (the “**Notes**”). Capitalized terms used in this notice which are defined in the Indenture and are not otherwise defined herein have the meanings specified for those terms in the Indenture.

Notice is hereby provided pursuant to Section 12.05(m) of the Indenture that an adjustment to the Conversion Rate for the Notes has been made pursuant to Section 12.05(d) of the Indenture.

Background

Section 12.05(d) of the Indenture provides that the Conversion Rate for the Notes shall be adjusted if the Ex-Dividend Date occurs for any cash dividend or distribution by the Company to all or substantially all holders of the outstanding Common Units (other than a regular quarterly cash distribution that does not exceed the Distribution Threshold). The Distribution Threshold is \$0.5950 per Common Unit. Under Section 12.05(i) of the Indenture, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Indenture, the Company will not be required to adjust the Conversion Rate unless such adjustment would require an increase or decrease of at least one percent; provided, however, that any such minor adjustments that are not required to be made will be carried forward and taken into account in any subsequent adjustment.

On October 23, 2024, the Board of Directors of the Company declared a distribution of \$0.9175 per Common Unit, payable on November 14, 2024, to the holders of record of its Common Units on November 6, 2024. The Ex-Dividend Date for the November 2024 distribution was November 6, 2024.

The Conversion Rate for the Notes was previously adjusted effective November 3, 2022 in order to account for eight (8) regular quarterly cash distributions in excess of the Distribution Threshold that were made following the issuance of the Notes, including the November 2022 distribution. The Conversion Rate for the Notes was further adjusted effective August 3, 2023 in order to account for three (3) regular quarterly cash distributions in excess of the Distribution Threshold that were made following November 3, 2022, including the August 2023 distribution. The Conversion Rate for the Notes was further adjusted effective February 5, 2024 in order to account for two (2) regular quarterly cash distributions in excess of the Distribution Threshold that were made following August 3, 2023, including the February 2024 distribution. The Conversion Rate for the Notes was further adjusted effective August 6, 2024 (the “**Prior Adjustment Date**”) in order to account for two (2) regular quarterly cash distributions in excess of the Distribution

Threshold that were made following February 5, 2024, including the August 2024 distribution. The Company has declared one (1) regular quarterly cash distribution in excess of the Distribution Threshold following the Prior Adjustment Date (i.e., the November 2024 distribution). An adjustment to the Conversion Rate for the Notes was triggered by the occurrence of the Ex-Dividend Date on November 6, 2024 for such regular quarterly cash distribution.

Adjustments

Effective immediately after the Open of Business on November 6, 2024, the Conversion Rate set forth in Section 12.01 of the Indenture is adjusted to 14.2454 Common Units (subject to future adjustment as provided in the Indenture) per \$1,000 principal amount of Notes.

The adjustment to the Conversion Rate was calculated using the formula in Section 12.05(d) of the Indenture. Related adjustments also have been made to the Unit Prices, number of potential Additional Common Units and Maximum Conversion Rate set forth in Section 12.07(d) of the Indenture as provided in Section 12.07(c).
